We normally don't provide food unless it's a cooking/birthday workshop. Always bring a drink in a named water bottle for you or your child.

The Forest Leader will carry a mobile phone at all times for emergency situations and to take photographs/short videos.

Insurance

The Forest Approach holds full Public Liability Insurance. Please be aware that activities take place over rough natural ground and although we take every precaution to ensure safe play, accidents may occur. The staff are all First Aid Trained, DBS checked, and we risk assess our site and put boundaries in place to ensure a safe experience for the children. Be prepared that your child will sometimes come home muddy and wet, but they will have had a great day!
